

## Another and Other

**Another** is used to refer to **one more thing** or **one more person**. **Another** is always **singular**.

Examples:

- I would like **another** cup of coffee.
- Can you give me **another** pencil?

**Other** is used as a **plural** to refer to **more than one thing or person**.

**Other** can be used as a **singular** to refer to an **alternative or replacement to the original version**.

Examples:

- Do you have any **other** books? (plural)
- I need **the other** pencil. (singular)
