# **Another** and **Other**

Another is used to refer to one more thing or one more person. Another is always singular.

## Examples:

- I would like another cup of coffee.
- Can you give me another pencil?

Other is used as a plural to refer to more than one thing or person.

Other can be used as a singular to refer to an alternative or replacement to the original version.

# Examples:

- Do you have any **other** books? (plural)
- I need the other pencil. (singular)
